A Study of Hata and Hatta't in Leviticus 4-5 Nobuyoshi Kiuchi, 2003 Through a close semantic analysis of the Hebrew terms hata and hatta t commonly translated as sin in Leviticus 4 5 this study reveals their lexical meanings unknown for two millennia both in Judaism and in Christianity Sin has been commonly understood as referring mainly to a violation of God s commandment pertaining to personal conduct However the revision Nobuyoshi Kiuchi proposes for the meanings of the terms has significant and far reaching implications for other major themes such as uncleanness and atonement meaning human salvation before God The author also provides a solution to the question of the relationship between sin and uncleanness

Ritual Words and Narrative Worlds in the Book of Leviticus Bryan D. Bibb, 2009-06-01 This book argues that literary features and ritual dynamics within the book of Leviticus enlighten each other The first two chapters establish that one may read Leviticus as a coherent literary work and define the genre of Leviticus as narrativized ritual a complex blending of descriptive narrative and prescriptive ritual In conversation with Catherine Bell they present several aspects of the text that are ritualized and show how this ritualization implies a negotiation of power relations among participants The third and fourth chapters examine the first half of Leviticus both the legal sections in Lev 1 7 and 11 15 and the narratives in Lev 8 10 and 16 These sections alternate between establishing the ritual system and exposing gaps and ambiguities in that system

Chapter 5 turns to the second half of Leviticus traditionally called the Holiness Code The ritual language found in this section is less formal and precise mirroring the way in which the concept of holiness is expanded and extended to the whole people As this material concludes the book it relativizes and democratizes the strict ritual system contained in the first half

Bridging the Gap Gerald A. description of the wilderness tabernacle and the instructions for the ordination ritual found in the Biblical books of Exodus and Leviticus. Although neglected by many modern readers who often find them technical and repetitive, the tabernacle accounts excited considerable interest amongst early scribes and readers as is evidenced by the survival of them in no fewer than four versions. Untangling this intricate compositional history helps shed light on how these chapters in the Pentateuch shaped and were shaped by the perception of the priesthood's powers and competencies during the Persian and early Hellenistic periods. The hierarchy that is developed is more nuanced and multifaceted than previously appreciated, with Israelite artisans, community leaders, Levites, and women incorporated into a complex vision of society. The ordination ritual was also transformed by scribal elites during the Persian period, appearing in no fewer than five variant forms as the role of the high priesthood and its relationship to other groups was negotiated. Using a broad plural methodological approach that incorporates insights from sociology, ritual studies, textual and literary criticism, early interpretation, manuscript studies, and philology, Nathan MacDonald's study shines new light on the historical development, theology, and ideology of priestly texts in the Pentateuch.

In addition to offering an overview of Paul's use of cultic metaphors and an assessment of Paul's synthesis of martyrology and cultic metaphor, this work shows how Paul uses still other metaphors: acquittal, reconciliation, adoption, to picture the beneficial after-effects of that death.
