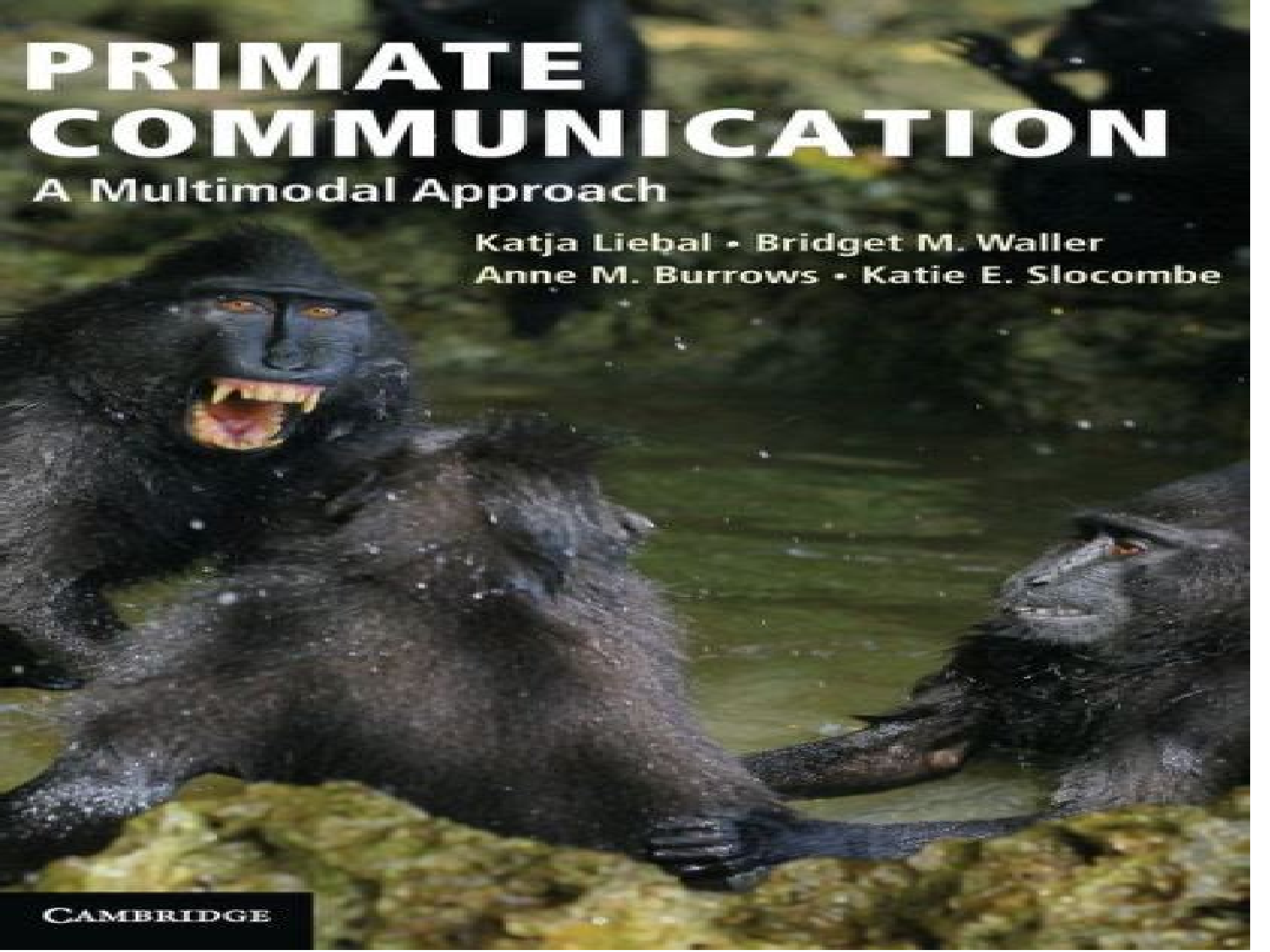

continued to evolve over the last 300 000 years of societal evolution These sociocultural forms of natural selection are labeled by the names of the early sociologists who first emphasized them and they can be seen as a necessary supplement to the type of natural selection theorized by Charles Darwin Explanations of religion that remain in the shadow cast by Darwin s great insights will it is argued remain narrow and incomplete when explaining a robust sociocultural phenomenon like religion
