Food Chain is one of the main economic pillars in Europe providing employment and opportunities for economic development in rural areas. It is therefore imperative to continuously monitor the changes that affect the sector in order to allow stakeholders to respond promptly and effectively to the new market conditions. Adjusting to the new market involves new technology, globalization, demographic and social changes within a challenging market environment. In order to adopt these new market parameters, food chain stakeholders need to adapt their activities in order to gain in terms of effectiveness and efficiency. Agri-food Chain Relationships Christian Fischer, Monika Hartmann, 2010. This book is the result of several years of research activity on the topic of how to better link farmers, processors and retailers with each other in order to ensure and improve the supply of food products which meet consumer needs and wants. The book is structured in three parts. Starting with an overview regarding main developments in the agri-food sector with relevance for chain relationships, chapter 1. Part I is mainly concerned with providing the theoretical foundations for analysing agrifood chain relations, chapters 2, 3 and 4. Building on this conceptual basis, the second part presents in depth empirical evidence for different countries' food chains and chain stages regarding the issues of trust and sustainable relationships in agri-food chains, chapters 5 to 14. The red meat industry, beef and pigmeat, is the focus of chapters 5, 7 and 9. Cereals, bread and malting barley are analysed in chapters 5, 7, 8, 10 and 13. Horticultural products, fresh produce and wine are investigated in chapters 6, 12 and 14. Regionally, the studies cover Europe, North America, the USA, China, Australia and the Philippines. While most studies were conducted in developed markets, chapters 6 and 12 look at the particularities of transition or developing economies. As to individual agri-food chain stakeholders, a number of chapters, chapters 5 to 12, 14 and 15, offer and discuss separate findings for farmers, food processors or retailers. Based on the theoretical and empirical findings in the first two parts of the book, recommendations for agribusiness managers, chapter 15, and policy makers, chapter 16, are described in the third part. Chapter 17 discusses avenues for future research.

Risk Management of Foodborne Zoonotic Bacteria from Farm to Table in the Nordic Countries, 2004. This report presents an overview of the existing risk management systems for food-borne zoonotic pathogens within each Nordic country, containing contributions from each country. Each contribution presents the overall food safety policy in that specific country and outlines the structure and organisation of the food control systems, the food safety legislation, the control and registration of foodstuffs and monitoring surveillance programmes. The report includes a discussion on views and experiences concerning risk management for food safety based on the farm-to-table continuum. The strengths and weaknesses of the risk management systems in the Nordic countries are discussed, and it is concluded that the process could be more structured so that the transparency and documentation of the process is improved.
