The Paradox of Evolution Stephen Rothman, 2015-12-01 This book examines a little noted contradiction inherent in the two essential elements of Darwin's theory of biological evolution natural selection and reproduction Physiologist Stephen Rothman makes the revolutionary claim that the evolution of life's complex and diverse reproductive mechanisms is not the consequence of natural selection In so doing he exposes the deepest question possible about life's nature its reason for being In meticulously detailed but accessible terms he lays out the crux of the paradox and offers an intriguing solution within a naturalistic framework In an ostensibly purposeless universe somehow purposeful life has evolved For all living things there are two overarching purposes survival and the creation of new life Natural selection is about the survival of existing life but has no interest in life's future about whether it persists or perishes By contrast reproduction is only about the future of life and has no interest in existing life except as a means to that end Where do these purposes come from As Rothman demonstrates at every level life is wired to react to danger Counterintuitively without the danger to its existence life would not have come into being As for reproduction nature's destructive forces drive the creation of new life Written with great clarity and informed by deep learning this elegant thoughtful work tackles some of the most challenging questions raised by the theory of evolution while calling to mind Darwin's famous words from the conclusion of *On the Origin of Species* There is a grandeur in this view of life

Baby Wars Robin Baker, 2018-05-07 First published in 1998 *Baby Wars* was the second title in a controversial trilogy of books which placed the past present and future of human reproduction under the microscope of evolutionary biology *Baby Wars* itself was focussed on parenthood and family strife and attracted such international interest that it was translated into

eight different languages This digital English edition with a new Preface by the authors was released in 2017 to celebrate the book's upcoming 20th anniversary Neither childhood nor parenthood is easy and to a greater or lesser extent babies mean wars in all families Some of these wars are subtle and physiological hidden from the conscious mind Others are obvious even aggressive and plain for all to see Even the most tranquil of families can experience conflict and for some life can become virtually a running battle But as *Baby Wars* shows there is an evolutionary rationale behind all of this disharmony It even emerges that without many of the conflicts most people would gain less than they do from their reproductive and family experience a paradox that forms one of the major themes of the book The book's format a hallmark of the whole trilogy is first to dramatise each topic as a fictionalised case study then to use the perspective of evolutionary biology to interpret the behaviour shown by the drama's main characters Topics covered range from the commonplace such as conception campaigns pregnancy sickness labour pains sleepless nights and grandparenthood to the illegal such as incest and child abuse Apart from the new Preface and an occasional minor correction or clarification the 20th Anniversary edition is a faithful digital version of the original paperback Yet despite the years since it was written this release of *Baby Wars* is as relevant now to the understanding of the evolved drivers of reproduction and parenthood as it was at the time of the first edition None of the scientific interpretations in the original book have been superseded in the interim Nor naturally has there been any change in those instincts of men women and children that are at the book's heart For anybody who wishes to understand why family life and strife has evolved to be as it is rather than how many would like it to be the answers can be found in *Baby Wars* pages

Proteins Crossing Membranes Stephen Rothman, 2019-01-17 In an intriguing series of experiments carried out many years ago a common scientific belief feted by no less than three Nobel prizes was brought into question The observations were about proteins the molecules that the genetic code specifies and that are in one way or another central to all of life's activities The experiments however were not about what proteins do but how they are moved in particular how they are moved from where they are made to where they act The results of these studies conflicted with the standard view of how this happens and thus became controversial The standard view the vesicle theory of protein secretion envisions proteins being carried within and out of cells en masse in membrane bound sacs or vesicles The controversial experiments demonstrated that to the contrary individual protein molecules cross the relevant membranes as a result of their own motion This was thought to be impossible at the time *Proteins Crossing Membranes* is a personal narrative that tells the story of the controversy Among other things the author illustrates that scientists like the rest of us can rigidly hold onto their beliefs despite evidence that they are misguided Key Features Reviews the data in support and critical of the vesicle theory of protein secretion Explores the ways scientists respond to evidence that challenges a favored theory Documents the author's personal experiences in this conflict laden situation

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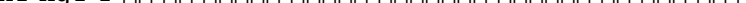
