The Gothic Fiction of Adelaida García Morales Abigail Lee Six, 2006 By highlighting features common to the Gothic classics and the works of Adelaida García Morales this monograph aims to put the Gothic on the map in Hispanic Studies The Gothic as a literary mode extending well beyond its first proponents in eighteenth century England is well established in English studies but has been strangely under used by Hispanists Now Abigail Lee Six uses it as the paradigm through which to analyse the novels of Adelaida García Morales while not suggesting that every novel by this author is a classic Gothic text she reveals certain constants in the work that can be related to the Gothic even in novels which one might not classify as such Each of the novels studied is paired with an English language Gothic text such as Dracula Frankenstein and Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde and then read in the light of it The focus of each chapter ranges from psychological aspects such as fear of decay or otherness or the pressures linked to managing secrets to more concrete elements such as mountains and frightening buildings and to key figures such as vampires ghosts or monsters This approach sheds new light on how García Morales achieves probably the most distinguishing feature of her novels their harrowing atmosphere

The Female Body in Medicine and Literature Andrew Mangham, Greta Depledge, 2013-08-15 Drawing on a range of texts from the seventeenth century to the present The Female Body in Medicine and Literature explores accounts of motherhood fertility and clinical procedures for what they have to tell us about the development of women's medicine The essays here offer nuanced historical analyses of subjects that have received little critical attention including the relationship between gynecology and psychology and the influence of popular art forms on so called women's science prior to the twenty first

century Taken together these essays offer a wealth of insight into the medical treatment of women and will appeal to scholars in gender studies literature and the history of medicine

Secondary Heroines in Nineteenth-Century British and American Novels Dr Jennifer Camden, 2013-04-28 Taking up works by Samuel Richardson James Fenimore Cooper Sir Walter Scott and Catharine Maria Sedgwick among others Jennifer B Camden examines the role of female characters who while embodying the qualities associated with heroines fail to achieve this status in the story These secondary heroines often the friend or sister of the primary heroine typically disappear from the action of the novel as the courtship plot progresses only to return near the conclusion of the action with renewed demands on the reader's attention Accounting for this persistent pattern Camden suggests reveals the cultural work performed by these unusual figures in the early history of the novel Because she is often a far more vivid character than the heroine of the marriage plot the secondary heroine inevitably engages the reader's interest in her plight That the narrative apparently seeks to suppress her creates tension and points to the secondary heroine as a site of contested identity who represents an ideology of womanhood and nationhood at odds with the national ideals represented by the primary heroine whom the reader is asked to embrace In showing how the anxiety produced by these ideals is displaced onto the secondary heroine Camden's study represents an important intervention into the ways in which early novels use character to further ideologies of race class sex and gender

Literature and Union Gerard Carruthers, Colin Kidd, 2018-01-05 *Literature and Union* opens up a new front in interdisciplinary literary studies There has been a great deal of academic work both in the Scottish context and more broadly on the relationship between literature and nationhood yet almost none on the relationship between literature and unions This volume introduces the insights of the new British history into mainstream Scottish literary scholarship The contributors who are from all shades of the political spectrum will interrogate from various angles the assumption of a binary opposition between organic Scottish values and those supposedly imposed by an overbearing imperial England Viewing Scottish literature as a clash between Scottish and English identities loses sight of the internal Scottish political and religious divisions which far more than issues of nationhood and union were the primary sources of conflict in Scottish culture for most of the period of Union until at least the early twentieth century The aim of the volume is to reconstruct the story of Scottish literature along lines which are more historically persuasive than those of the prevailing grand narratives in the field The chapters fall into three groups 1 those which highlight canonical moments in Scottish literary Unionism John Bull Rule Britannia Humphry Clinker Ivanhoe and England their England 2 those which investigate key themes and problems including the Unions of 1603 and 1707 Scottish Augustanism the Burns Cult Whig Presbyterian and sentimental Jacobite literatures and 3 comparative pieces on European and Anglo Irish phenomena

Riots in Literature David Bell, Gerald Porter, 2009-05-27 *Riots in Literature* addresses representations of crowd disorder as manifestations of popular politics including colonial and postcolonial contexts The terms used to describe disorder are themselves of course contested Words like mob demonstration and protest not to mention riot

itself denote a particular perspective based on an elitist taxonomy for dealing with social and cultural phenomena in society. Of primary concern is the way in which the text describes and designates crowd behaviour using the language of denigration, metaphors of the primitive and animalistic, brutal images and silences, and where the mediation of the event is expressed in terms of the binary order/disorder. The contributors to this volume are interested in the analysis of the interaction of official political culture and crowd politics as represented in literature and orature, and how such representations contribute to the discourses of authority and subversion of their period. The essays are wide-ranging and explore the phenomenon of riots in literature through studies of popular risings in Shakespeare, Carlyle, and the French Revolution; the Rebecca Riots in Wales; popular ballads and the Indian War of Independence in 1857; post-partition riots in India and Pakistan in the 1960s; township violence in South African fiction post 1948; the 1965 Watts riots in Los Angeles in detective fiction; and avant-garde disturbances in France of the 1920s and 1930s. Throughout the book, these essays focus attention on the tension-filled relationship that is perceived between literature and discourses of power and popular resistance.
