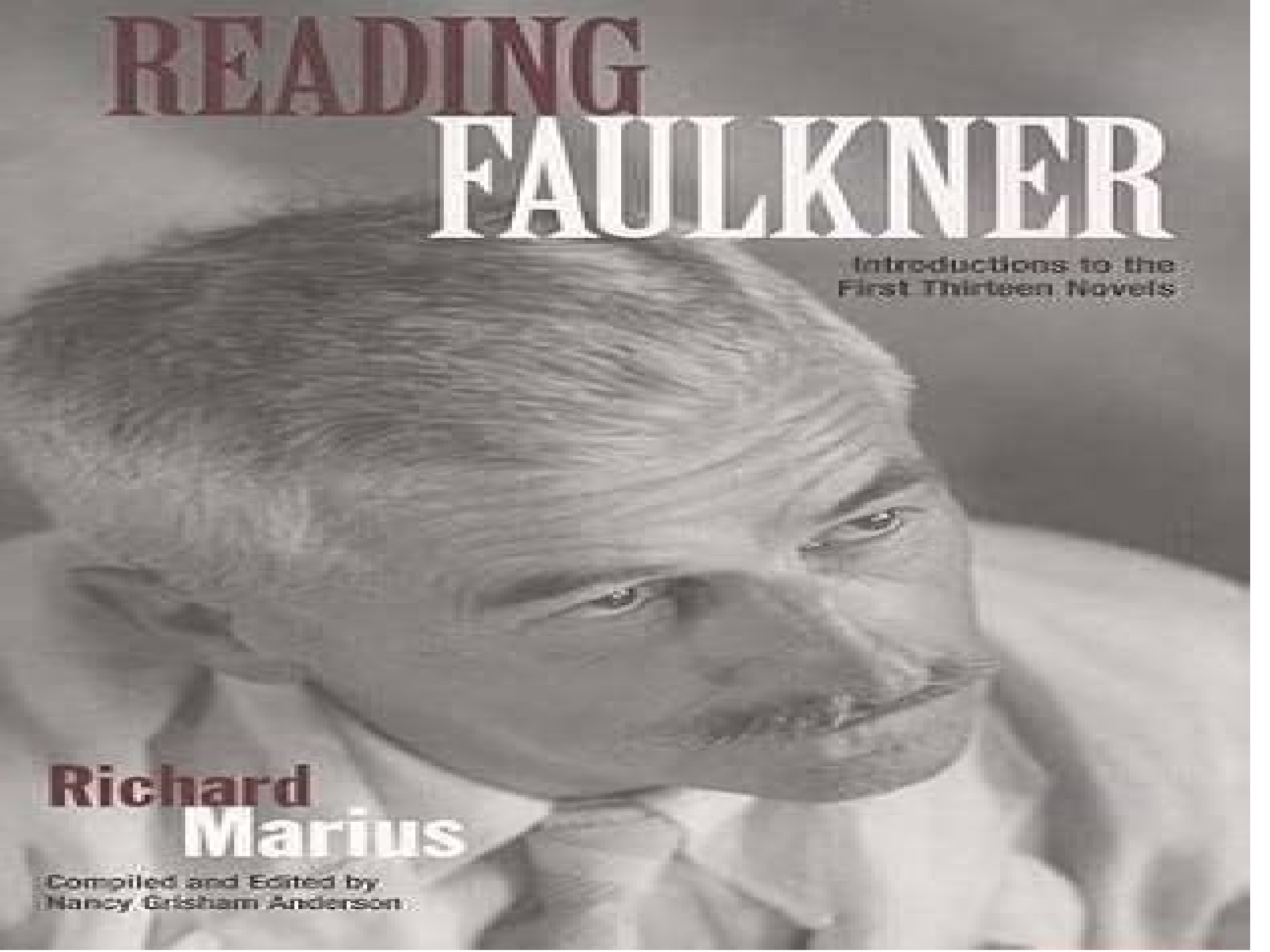

Reading Faulkner Richard Marius, 2006 Soldiers pay Mosquitoes Flags in the dust Faulkner and Blacks The sound and the fury As I lay dying Sanctuary Light in August Pylon Absalom Absalom The unvanquished The wild palms The hamlet Faulkner and the mythological world Go down Moses *Student Companion to William Faulkner* John Dennis Anderson, 2007-09-30 One of America's greatest writers William Faulkner wrote fiction that combined spellbinding Southern storytelling with modernist formal experimentation to shape an enduring body of work In his fictional Yoknapatawpha County based on the region around his hometown of Oxford Mississippi he created an entire world peopled with unforgettable characters linked into an intricate historical and social web An introduction to the Nobel Prize winning author's life and work this book devotes opening chapters to his biography and literary heritage and subsequent chapters to each of his major works The analytical chapters start with his most accessible book The Unvanquished a Civil War era account of a boy's coming of age The following chapters orient readers to elements of plot character and theme in Faulkner's masterpieces The Sound and the Fury As I Lay Dying Light in August and Absalom Absalom Also analyzed and discussed are some of Faulkner's most often anthologized short stories including A Rose For Emily and Barn Burning and the longer stories The Bear Spotted Horses and The Old Man that were incorporated in the novels Go Down Moses The Hamlet and If I Forget Thee Jerusalem Clear insightful analyses of the elements of Faulkner's fiction are supplemented with alternative readings from a variety of critical approaches including gender rhetorical performance and cultural studies perspectives Wrestling with God Richard Marius, 2006 Historian novelist and masterful teacher Richard Marius struggled with religious belief throughout his life His very devout mother taught him to memorize the Bible from a very early age and influenced him to make a commitment to enter the ministry when he was a senior in high school However during his first year at the University of Tennessee his faith was shaken by a reading assignment in freshman English an essay in which the author argues that the universe is purposeless and meaningless After receiving a Bachelor of Divinity degree from Southern Baptist Seminary in Louisville Kentucky Marius attended graduate school at Yale University to study Renaissance and Reformation history receiving a PhD in history with a dissertation on Sir Thomas More During his years as a student he occasionally held the position of supply pastor but after graduation from Yale he decided to enter the academic world as a history professor And he continued to preach when the opportunity arose Wrestling with God is a collection of twenty three sermons or meditations delivered in a variety of settings and spanning Richard Marius's adult life from the late 1950s until a few months before his death Many of them were delivered at Morning Prayers a daily service in the Appleton Chapel of the Memorial Church at Harvard University In these selections he explores the questions of faith and doubt belief and unbelief good and evil His explications are informed by an eclectic knowledge of the Bible art and architecture music literature history philosophy and theology politics and current events travel and languages A skeptical humanist Marius nevertheless was infused with his own

kind of religious feeling and his struggle to find meaning and purpose in his life will resonate with all readers who struggle with the ultimate questions of existence **Robert Penn Warren, Critic** Charlotte H. Beck, 2006 Using a largely chronological approach Charlotte Beck has carefully traced the evolution of Warren's criticism focusing on seminal examples of the critical books, essays, and introductions that Warren produced over a period of almost seventy years. Her conclusions often run counter to previous evaluations of Warren's criticism, especially to those that complacently link Warren to Cleanth Brooks, his lifelong friend and collaborator, and to New Criticism in general. Beck demonstrates that Warren consistently treats writers holistically, taking into account biographical as well as historical data to account for their entire body of work rather than focusing on a single literary text. Faulkner's Short Fiction James Ferguson, 1991 This comprehensive overview of William Faulkner's short fiction is a systematic study of this body of work which Faulkner produced over a period of forty years. A chronological survey of Faulkner's career as a writer of short fiction is followed by chapters devoted to aspects of Faulkner's craft: thematic patterns, points of view, and other technical and formal patterns. The author offers a frank assessment of Faulkner's failures and successes as a writer of short fiction.

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
