Musically Sublime Indeterminacy Infinity Irresolvability:

Musically Sublime Kiene Brillenburg Wurth, 2009-08-25 *Musically Sublime* rewrites musically the history and philosophy of the sublime Music enables us to reconsider the traditional course of sublime feeling on a track from pain to pleasure Resisting the notion that there is a single format for sublime feeling Wurth shows how from the mid eighteenth century onward sublime feeling is instead constantly rearticulated in a complex interaction with musicality Wurth takes as her point of departure Immanuel Kant's Critique of Judgment and Jean-François Lyotard's aesthetic writings of the 1980s and 1990s Kant framed the sublime narratively as an epic of self-transcendence By contrast Lyotard sought to substitute open immanence for Kantian transcendence yet he failed to deconstruct the Kantian epic The book performs this deconstruction by juxtaposing eighteenth and nineteenth century conceptions of the infinite Sehnsucht the divided self and unconscious drives with contemporary readings of instrumental music Critically assessing Edmund Burke James Usher E.T.A. Hoffmann Novalis Friedrich Hölderlin Arthur Schopenhauer Richard Wagner and Friedrich Nietzsche this book re-presents the sublime as a feeling that defers resolution and hangs suspended between pain and pleasure *Musically Sublime* rewrites the mathematical sublime as difference while it redresses the dynamical sublime as trauma unending undetermined unresolved Whereas most musicological studies in this area have focused on traces of the Kantian sublime in Handel Haydn and Beethoven this book calls on the nineteenth century theorist Arthur Schopenhauer to analyze the sublime of rather than in music It does so by invoking Schopenhauer's concept of *Formwidrigkeit* form-contrariness in juxtaposition with Romantic piano music postmodernist musical minimalisms and Lyotard's postmodern sublime It presents a sublime of matter rather than form performative rather than representational In doing so *Musically Sublime* shows that the binary distinction Lyotard posits between the postmodern and romantic sublime is finally untenable

Modernism and the Cult of Mountains: Music, Opera, Cinema Christopher Morris, 2016-04-15 Adopting and transforming the Romantic fascination with mountains modernism in the German-speaking lands claimed the Alps as a space both of resistance and of escape This new cult of mountains reacted to the symptoms and alienating forces associated with modern culture defining and reinforcing models of subjectivity based on renewed wholeness and an aggressive attitude to physical and mental health The arts were critical to this project none more so than music which occupied a similar space in Austro-German culture autonomous pure sublime In *Modernism and the Cult of Mountains* opera serves as a nexus shedding light on the circulation of contesting ideas about politics nature technology and aesthetics Morris investigates operatic representations of the high mountains in German modernism showing how the liminal quality of the landscape forms the backdrop for opera's reflexive engagement with the identity and limits of its constituent media not least music This operatic reflexivity in which the very question of music's identity is repeatedly restaged invites consideration of musical encounters with mountains in other genres and Morris shows how these issues resonate in Strauss's Alpine Symphony and in the Bergfilm mountain film By using music and the ideology of mountains to illuminate aspects of each

other Morris makes an original and valuable contribution to the critical study of modernism

Theology, Music, and Modernity Jeremy Begbie, Daniel K L Chua, Markus Rathey, 2021-02-02 Theology Music and Modernity addresses the question how can the study of music contribute to a theological reading of modernity It has grown out of the conviction that music has often been ignored in narrations of modernity's theological struggles Featuring contributions from an international team of distinguished theologians musicologists and music theorists the volume shows how music and discourse about music has remarkable powers to bring to light the theological currents that have shaped modern culture It focuses on the concept of freedom concentrating on the years 1740 1850 a period when freedom especially religious and political freedom became a burning matter of concern in virtually every stratum of Western society The collection is divided into four sections each section focusing on a key phenomenon of this period the rise of the concept of revolutionary freedom the move of music from church to concert hall the cry for eschatological justice in the work of black hymn writer and church leader Richard Allen and the often fierce tensions between music and language There is a particular concern to draw on a distinctively Scriptural imagination especially the theme of New Creation in order to elicit the key issues at stake and to suggest constructive ways forward for a contemporary Christian theological engagement with the legacies of modernity today

Peculiar Attunements Roger Mathew Grant, 2020-03-03 Peculiar Attunements places the recent turn to affect into conversation with a parallel movement in European music theory of the eighteenth century During that time the affects or passions as they were also called formed a vital component of a mimetic model of the arts

Eighteenth century critics held that artworks imitated or copied the natural world in order to produce copies of the affects in their beholders But music caused a problem for such theories since it wasn't apparent that musical tones could imitate anything with any dependability beyond the rare thunderclap or birdcall Struggling to articulate how it was that music managed to move its auditors without imitation certain theorists developed a new affect theory crafted especially for music postulating that music's physical materiality as sound vibrated the nerves of listeners and attuned them to the affects through sympathetic resonance This was a theory of affective attunement that bypassed the entire structure of representation offering a non discursive corporeal alternative It is a pendant to contemporary theories of affect and one from which they have much to learn Inflecting our current intellectual moment through eighteenth century music theory and aesthetics this book offers a reassessment of affect theory's common systems and processes It offers a new way of thinking through affect dialectically drawing attention to patterns and problems in affect theory that we have been given to repeating Finally taking a cue from eighteenth century theory it gives renewed attention to the objects that generate affects in subjects

Pleasure: A History Lisa Shapiro, 2018-06-05 For many the word pleasure conjures associations with hedonism indulgence and escape from the life of the mind However little we talk about it though pleasure also plays an integral role in cognitive life in both our sensory perception of the world and our intellectual understanding This previously important but now neglected philosophical understanding of pleasure is the focus of the essays in this volume which challenges received views that pleasure is principally motivating of action unanalyzable and caused rather than responsive to reason Like other books in the Oxford Philosophical Concepts series it traces the development of the focal idea from ancient times through the 20th century The essays highlight points of departure for new lines of inquiry rather than attempting to provide a full picture of how the idea of pleasure has been explored in philosophy The volume begins by showing how Plato Aristotle early Islamic philosophers and philosophers in the Medieval Latin tradition such as Aquinas honed in on the challenge of unifying the variety of pleasures so that they fall under one concept In the early modern period philosophers shifted from understanding the logic of pleasure to treating pleasure as a mental state As the studies of Malebranche Berkeley and Kant show the central problem becomes understanding the relation of pleasure to other sensory experiences and the role of pleasure in human cognition and knowledge Short interdisciplinary reflections interspersed between essays focus on art of 16th and 17th century textbooks and the difficult music of composers like Bach which demonstrate translation of these concerns to cultural production in the period As the essay on Mill shows the 19th century development of scientific psychology narrowed the definition of pleasure and so its philosophical focus Contemporary accounts of pleasure however in both philosophy and psychology are now recognizing the limitations of this narrow focus and are once again recognizing the complexity of pleasure and its role in human life

Aesthetics of Music Stephen Downes, 2014-06-27 Aesthetics of Music Musicological Approaches is an anthology of fourteen essays each addressing a single key concept or pair of terms in the aesthetics of

Music and the Sonorous Sublime in European Culture, 1680-1880 Sarah Hibberd, Miranda Stanyon, 2020-05-28 The sublime that elusive encounter with overwhelming height power or limits has been associated with music from the early modern rise of interest in the Longinian sublime to its saturation of European culture in the later nineteenth century and beyond This volume offers a historically situated study of the relationship between music sound and the sublime Together the authors distinguish between the different aesthetics of production representation and effect while understanding these as often mutually reinforcing approaches They demonstrate music s strength in playing out the sublime as transfer transport and transmission of power allied to the persistent theme of destruction deaths and endings The volume opens up two avenues for further research suggested by the adjective sonorous a wider spectrum of sounds heard as sublime and especially for those outside musicology a more multifaceted idea of music as a cultural practice that shares boundaries with other sounding phenomena

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
