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Theses on the Metaphors of Digital-Textual History Martin Paul Eve, 2024-07-16 Digital spaces are saturated with metaphor we have pages sites mice and windows Yet in the world of digital textuality these metaphors no longer function as we might expect Martin Paul Eve calls attention to the digital textual metaphors that condition our experience of digital space and traces their history as they interact with physical cultures Eve posits that digital textual metaphors move through three life phases Initially they are descriptive Then they encounter a moment of fracture or rupture Finally they go on to have a prescriptive life of their own that conditions future possibilities for our text environments even when the metaphors have become untethered from their original intent Why is whitespace white Was the digital page always a foregone conclusion Over a series of theses Eve addresses these and other questions in order to understand the moments when digital textual metaphors break and to show us how it is that our textual softwares become locked into paradigms that no longer make sense Contributing to book history literary studies new media studies and material textual studies *Theses on the Metaphors of Digital Textual History* provides generative insights into the metaphors that define our digital worlds

Facsimiles and the History of Shakespeare Editing Paul Salzman, 2023-06-22 Is a facsimile an edition In answering this question in relation to Shakespeare and to early modern writing in general the author explores the interrelationship between the beginning of the conventional process of collecting and editing Shakespeare's plays and the increasing sophistication of facsimiles While recent scholarship has offered a detailed account of how Shakespeare was edited in the eighteenth century the parallel process of the exact reproduction of his texts has been largely ignored The author will explain how facsimiles moved during the eighteenth and nineteenth century from hand drawn traced and type facsimiles to the advent of photographic facsimiles in the mid nineteenth century Facsimiles can be seen as a

barometer of the reverence accorded to the idea of an authentic Shakespeare text and also of the desire to possess if not original texts then reproductions of them **Printing History and Cultural Change** Richard Wendorf, 2022 This study provides one of the most detailed and comprehensive examinations ever devoted to a critical transformation in the material substance of the printed page it carries out this exploration in the history of the book moreover by embedding these typographical changes in the context of other cultural phenomena in eighteenth century Britain The gradual abandonment of pervasive capitalization italics and caps and small caps in books printed in London Dublin and the American colonies between 1740 and 1780 is mapped in five year increments which reveal that the appearance of the modern page in English began to emerge around 1765 This descriptive and analytical account focuses on poetry classical texts Shakespeare contemporary plays the novel the Bible the Book of Common Prayer sermons and religious writings newspapers magazines anthologies government publications and private correspondence it also examines the reading public canon formation editorial theory and practice and the role of typography in textual interpretation These changes in printing conventions are then compared to other aspects of cultural change the adoption of the Gregorian calendar in 1752 the publication of Johnson's Dictionary in 1755 the transformation of shop signs and the imposition of house numbers in London beginning in 1762 and the evolution of the English language and of English prose style This study concludes that this fundamental shift in printing conventions was closely tied to a pervasive interest in refinement regularity and standardization in the second half of the century and that it was therefore an important component in the self-conscious process of modernizing British culture publisher's website
