From Sovereignty to Solidarity Harald Bauder, 2022-02-13 From Sovereignty to Solidarity seeks to re-imagine human mobility in ways that are de-linked from national sovereignty. Using examples from around the world, the author examines contemporary practices of solidarity to illustrate what such a conceptualization of human mobility looks like. He suggests that urban and local scales rather than the national scale is a better way to frame human migration and belonging. The book ultimately proposes that solidarity rather than sovereignty offers an alternative approach to imagine how human mobility should and already does occur. This book will be relevant to upper level undergraduate and graduate students in disciplines such as Migration Studies, Urban Studies, Human and Political Geography and Refugee Studies. It is also relevant to researchers, development workers and human rights, environmental activists and other intellectual practitioners.

City-making, Space and Spirituality Stéphan de Beer, 2023-09-29 This book is about the soul of the city embodied in its spaces and people. It traces dynamics in inner city neighbourhoods of South Africa's post-apartheid capital Pretoria. Viewing the city through its most vulnerable people and places, it recognizes that urban space is never neutral and shaped by competing value frameworks. The first part of the book invites planners, city makers and ordinary urban citizens to consider a new self-understanding, reclaiming their agency in the city-making process. Through the metaphor of becoming like children, planning practice is deconstructed and re-imagined. A praxis-based methodology is presented, cultivating four distinct moments of entering, reading, imagining and co-constructing the city. After deconstructing urban spaces and discourses, the second part of the book explores a concrete spirituality and ethic of urban space. It argues for a shift from planning as technocracy to planning as immersed participatory artistry, opening up to the genius of space responsive to urban cries and joining to construct new soul-full spaces. Local communities and interconnected movements become embodiments of urban alternatives through resistance and reconstruction, building on local assets, animating local reclamations and weaving nets of

hope that will span the entire city Providing a concrete methodology for city making that is rooted in a community based urban praxis this book will be of interest to urban planning researchers professional planners and designers and also grass root community developers or activists

The Food Insecurities of Zimbabwean Migrants in Urban South Africa Crush, Jonathan, Tawodzera, Godfrey, 2016-10-17 This report examines the food security status of Zimbabwean migrant households in the poorer areas of two major South African cities Johannesburg and Cape Town The vast majority were food insecure in terms of the amount of food to which they had access and the quality and diversity of their diet What seems clear is that Zimbabwean migrants are significantly more food insecure than other low income households The primary reason for this appears to lie in pressures that include remittances of cash and goods back to family in Zimbabwe The small literature on the impact of migrant remittances on food security tends to look only at the recipients and how their situation is improved It does not look at the impact of remitting on those who send remittances Most Zimbabwean migrants in South Africa feel a strong obligation to remit but to do so they must make choices because of their limited and

unpredictable income Food is one of the first things to be sacrificed Quantities decline cheaper foods are preferred and dietary quality and diversity inevitably suffer This study found that while migrants were dissatisfied with the shrinking job market in South Africa most felt that they would be unlikely to find work in Zimbabwe and that a return would worsen their household's food security situation In other words while food insecurity in Zimbabwe is a major driver of migration to South Africa food insecurity in South Africa is unlikely to encourage many to return *The Blinded City* Matthew

Wilhelm-Solomon, 2022-07-01 Shortlisted for the 2023 Sunday Times Literary Awards One of the best works of narrative non-fiction to emerge from the country in years Quite simply brilliant NIREN TOLSI Amid evictions raids killings the drug trade and fire inner city Johannesburg residents seek safety and a home A grandmother struggles to keep her granddaughter as she is torn away from her A mother seeks healing in the wake of her son's murder And displaced by the city's drive for urban regeneration a group of blind migrants try to carve out an existence *The Blinded City* recounts the history of inner city Johannesburg from 2010 to 2019 primarily from the perspectives of the unlawful occupiers of spaces known as hijacked buildings bad buildings or dark buildings Tens of thousands of residents both South African and foreign national live in these buildings in dire conditions This book tells the story of these sites and the court cases around them which strike at the centre of who has the right to occupy the city In February 2010 while Johannesburg prepared for the FIFA World Cup the South Gauteng High Court ordered the eviction of the unlawful occupiers of an abandoned carpet factory on Saratoga Avenue and that the city's Metropolitan Municipality provide temporary emergency accommodation for the evicted The case which became known as Blue Moonlight and went to the Constitutional Court catalysed a decade of struggles over housing and eviction in Johannesburg *The Blinded City* chronicles this case among others and the aftermath a tumultuous period in the city characterised by recurrent dispossessions police and immigration operations outbursts of xenophobic violence and political and legal change All through the decade there is the backdrop of successive mayors and their attempts to clean up the city and the struggles of residents and urban housing activists for homes and a better life The interwoven narratives present a compelling mosaic of life in post-apartheid Johannesburg one of the globe's most infamous and vital cities
