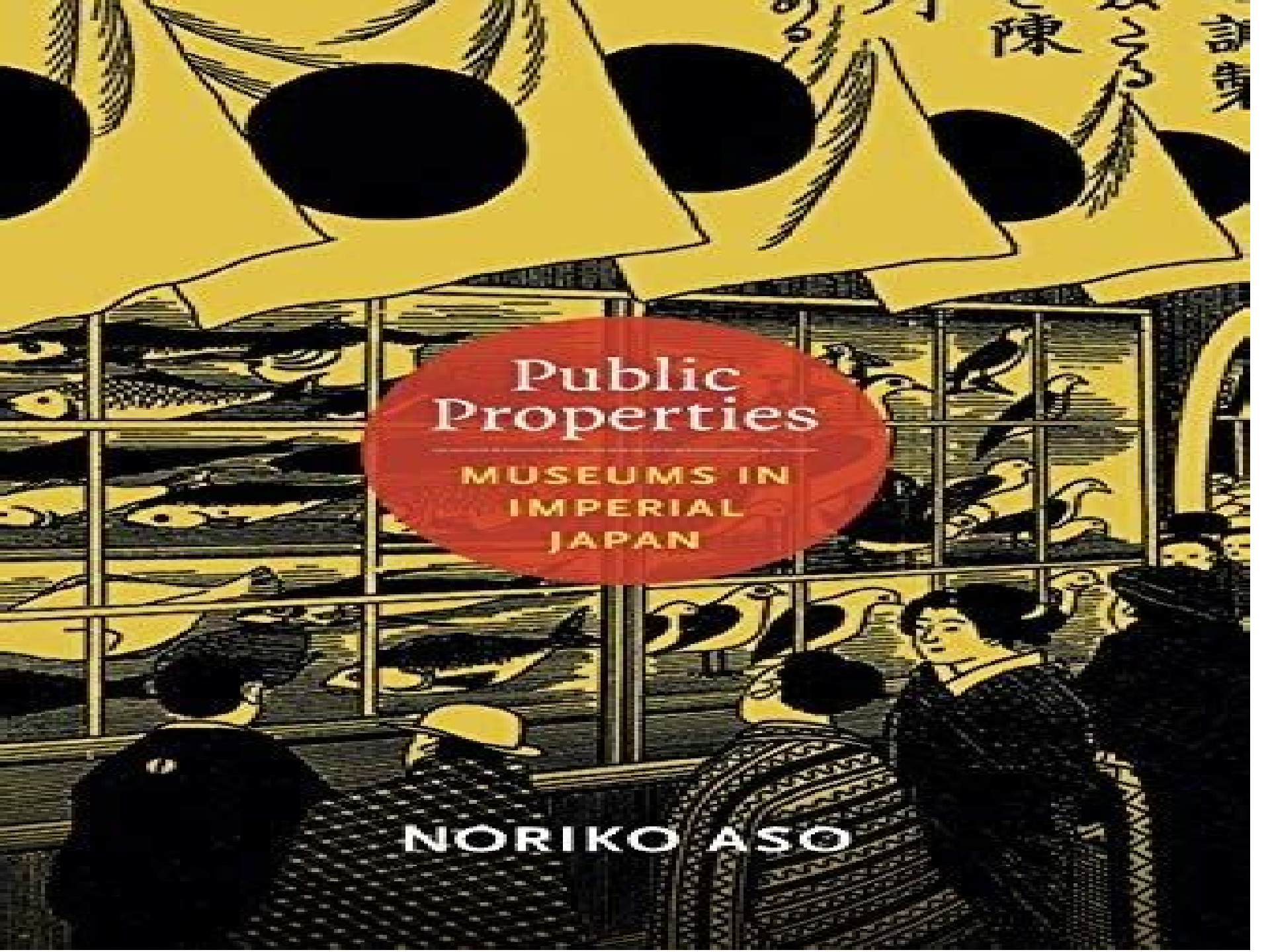

Public Properties Noriko Aso,2013-11-27 In the late nineteenth century Japan's new Meiji government established museums to showcase a national aesthetic heritage. Inspired by Western museums and expositions, these institutions were introduced by government officials hoping to spur industrialization and self-disciplined public behavior and to cultivate an imperial public loyal to the emperor. Japan's network of museums expanded along with its colonies. By the mid 1930s the Japanese museum system had established or absorbed institutions in Taiwan, Korea, Sakhalin, and Manchuria. Not surprising, colonial subjects' views of Japanese imperialism differed from those promulgated by the Japanese state. Meanwhile in Japan, philanthropic and commercial museums were expanding, revising, and even questioning the state-sanctioned aesthetic canon. *Public Properties* describes how museums in Japan and its empire contributed to the reimagining of state and society during the imperial era despite vigorous disagreements about what was to be displayed, how, and by whom it was to be seen.

Asia and the Pacific Ocean through the ideology of imperial stewardship a view that encompassed both genuine curiosity and care for Chinese art and the enduring structures of domination and othering that underpinned the burgeoning transpacific art market Tracing both transatlantic and transpacific networks across the Pacific and the Atlantic K Ian Shin uncovers a diverse cast of historical actors that both contributed to US imperial stewardship and also challenged it including Protestant missionaries German diplomats Chinese Hawaiian merchants and Chinese overseas students among others By examining the development of Chinese art collecting and scholarship in the United States around the turn of the twentieth century Imperial Stewards reveals both the cultural impetus behind Americans long standing aspirations for a Pacific Century and a way to understand and critique the duality of US imperial power around the globe [The Art of Persistence](#) Charlotte Eubanks,2019-12-31 The Art of Persistence examines the relations between art and politics in transwar Japan exploring these via a microhistory of the artist memoirist and activist Akamatsu Toshiko also known as Maruki Toshi 1912 2000 Scaling up from the details of Akamatsu s lived experience the book addresses major events in modern Japanese history including colonization and empire war the nuclear bombings and the transwar proletarian movement More broadly it outlines an ethical position known as persistence which occupies the grey area between complicity and resistance Like resilience persistence signals a commitment to not disappearing a fierce act of taking up space but often from a position of privilege among the classes and people in power Akamatsu grew up in a settler colonial family in rural Hokkaido before attending arts college in Tokyo and becoming one of the first women to receive formal training as an oil painter in Japan She later worked as a governess in the home of a Moscow diplomat and traveled to the Japanese Mandate in Micronesia before returning home to write and illustrate children s books set in the Pacific She married the surrealist poet and painter Maruki Iri 1901 1995 and together in 1948 and in defiance of Occupation censorship they began creating and exhibiting the Nuclear Series some of the most influential and powerful artwork depicting the aftermath of the Hiroshima bombing For the next forty or more years the couple toured the world to protest war and nuclear proliferation and were nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize in 1995 With abundant excerpts and drawings from Akamatsu s journals and sketchbooks The Art of Persistence offers a bridge between scholarship on imperial Japan and postwar memory cultures arguing for the importance of each individual s historical agency While uncovering the longue dur e of Japan s visual cultures of war it charts the development of the nationalist literature for little citizens movement and Japan s postwar reorientation toward global multiculturalism Finally the work proposes ways to enlist artwork generally and the museum specifically as a site of ethical engagement **Japan's Empire of Birds** Annika A. status She goes on to explore issues of masculinity and race related to this amidst the backdrop of imperial Japan's interwar period of peaceful internationalism the rise of fascism the Japanese takeover of Manchuria and war in China and the Pacific Culver concludes by investigating how these scientists repurposed their aims during Japan's Allied Occupation and the Cold War Inspired by geographer Doreen Massey themes covered in the volume include social space and place in these specific locations and how identities transform to garner social capital and scientific credibility in transnational associations and travel for non white scientists
