that Mencius cannot do so given the distinctive twist he gives to self examination in response to mistreatment Xunzi by contrast leaves open a door to forgiveness that Mencius bolted shut The book then proceeds to the Roman Stoics Musonius Rufus Epictetus Marcus Aurelius and Seneca arguing that their distinctive conceptions of value and wellbeing rule out forgiveness though like the Confucians the Stoics offer alternatives to forgiveness well worth considering The book ends by comparing the two traditions arguing that while Stoicism helps us navigate many of the turbulent waters of everyday life Confucianism enjoys advantages when we interact with those to whom we are bound by ties of affection and intimacy
