

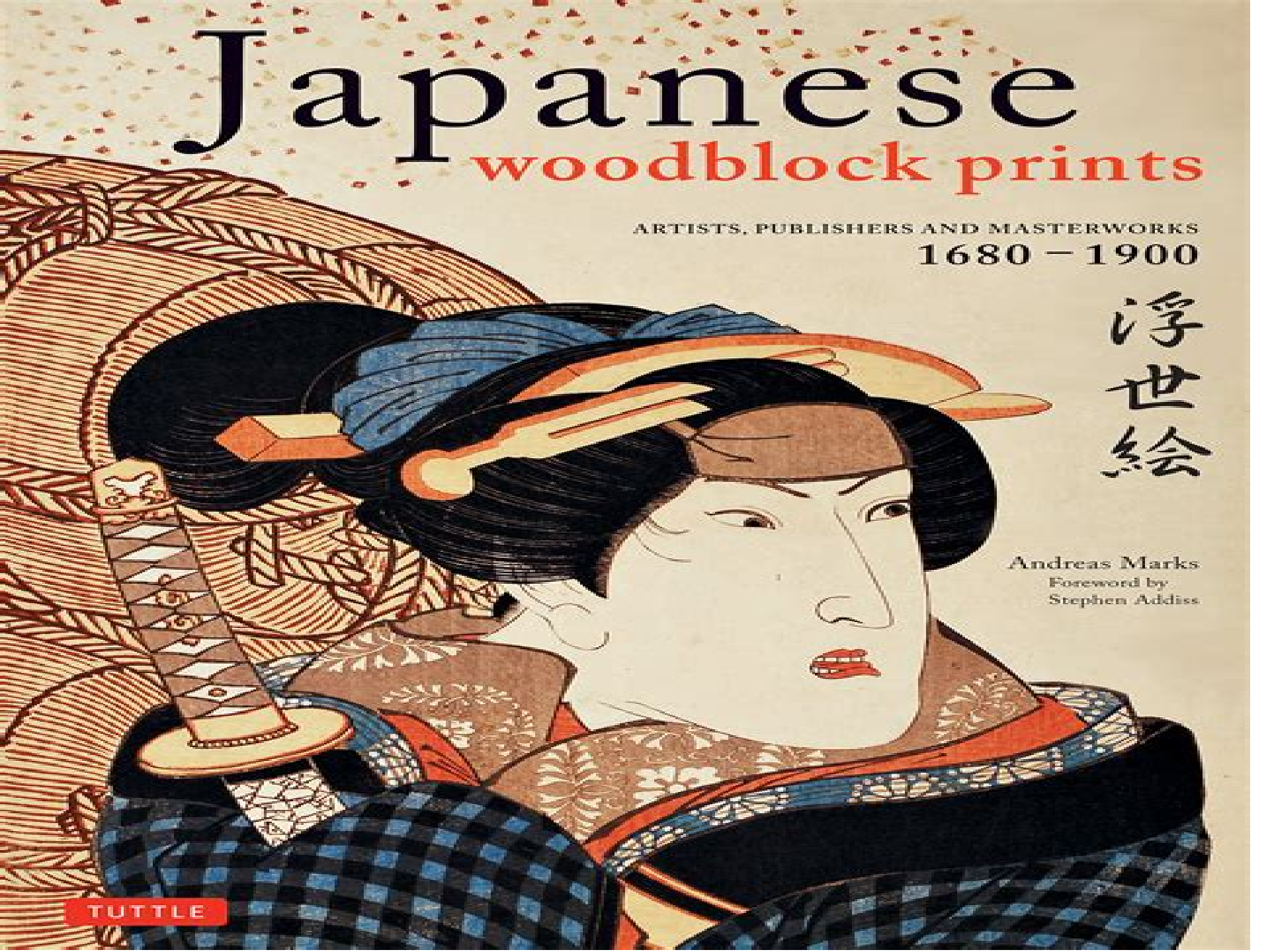

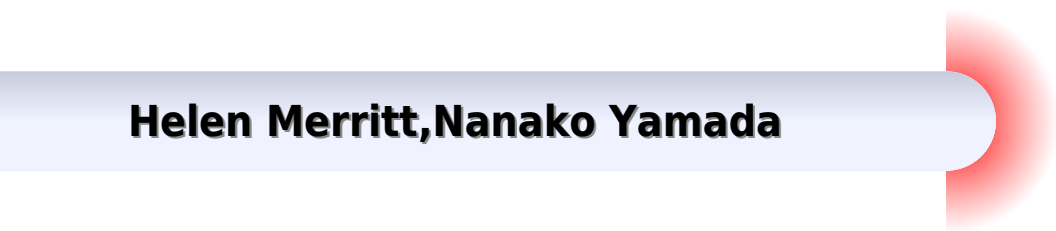

Prosperi, Tenha Seher, Rune Steenberg, Freya Terryn, Robert Tsaturyan, Jessica Uldry, 2023 This volume consists of 19 chapters that reflect the titular theme *Voiced and Voiceless in Asia* from a variety of angles making use of diverse scholarly approaches and disciplines while focusing specifically on China India Japan and Taiwan The chapters are broadly divided into two parts 1 Politics and Society and 2 Arts and Literature although the texts included in the second part also deal with social themes In addition to historical topics such as Japanese colonialism or Chinese agricultural reforms in the 1950s the volume also addresses current issues including restrictive Chinese policies in Xinjiang Japanese activist movements against gender based violence and discrimination or the problems of migrant laborers in India and performing arts in Japan during the COVID 19 pandemic Likewise it provides insight into satirical woodblock prints from the Boshin War period or works of literature produced in Japanese leprosariums in the first half of the 20th century as well as into selected topics in

contemporary Chinese Japanese and Sinophone Tibetan literature Collectively the chapters comprised in this volume narrate the multifaceted relationship between voice and power thus highlighting the fact that the question of voice is closely intertwined with a variety of social political and cultural issues

Branding Japanese Food Katarzyna J. Cwiertka, Yasuhara Miho, 2020-02-29 *Branding Japanese Food* is the first book in English on the use of food for the purpose of place branding in Japan At the center of the narrative is the 2013 inscription of Washoku traditional dietary cultures of the Japanese notably for the celebration of New Year on UNESCO's Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity The authors challenge the very definition of washoku as it was presented in the UNESCO nomination and expose the multitude of contradictions and falsehoods used in the promotion of Japanese cuisine as part of the nation branding agenda Cwiertka and Yasuhara argue further that the manipulation of historical facts in the case of washoku is actually a continuation of similar practices employed for centuries in the branding of foods as iconic markers of tourist attractions They draw parallels with gastronomic meibutsu famous products and edible omiyage souvenirs which since the early modern period have been persistently marketed through questionable connections with historical personages and events Today meibutsu and omiyage play a central role in the travel experience in Japan and comprise a major category in the practices of gift exchange Few seem to mind that the stories surrounding these foods are hardly ever factual despite the fact that the stories rather than the food itself constitute the primary attraction The practice itself is derived from the intellectual exercise of evoking specific associations and sentiments by referring to imaginary landscapes known as utamakura or meisho At first restricted to poetry this exercise was expanded to the visual arts and by the early modern period familiarity with specific locations and the culinary associations they evoked had become a fixed component of public collective knowledge The construction of the myths of meibutsu omiyage and washoku as described in this book not only enriches the understanding of Japanese culinary culture but also highlights the dangers of tweaking history for branding purposes and the even greater danger posed by historians remaining silent in the face of this irreversible reshaping of the past into a consumable product for public enjoyment

Japan's Book Donation to the University of Louvain Eline Mennens, 2022-10-10 With more than 3 000 titles in almost 14 000 volumes the 1920s Japanese book donation to the University of Leuven Louvain constitutes an invaluable time capsule of Japan's pre modern culture in all its diversity and richness A century on the time is right to take a new look at its contents as well as its history and the political social and cultural context surrounding the donation To commemorate its centenary the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven KU Leuven and the Universit catholique de Louvain UCLouvain have joined forces to set up a special exhibition under the title *Japan's Book Donation to the University of Louvain Japanese Cultural Identity and Modernity in the 1920s* October 2022 January 2023 at the University Library of KU Leuven The present book has been compiled for the occasion of the exhibition to serve as a durable guide to the magnificent book donation and its historical background and as a reference for further research in the future In five essays by historians of politics media

culture and arts of Japan it offers a richly illustrated overview of the history of the donation and its wider historical context providing illuminating insights into the vibrant 1920s in Japan its politics society and popular culture The reader is further invited to explore a sample of 65 remarkable and rare items from the donation which were carefully selected for inclusion in the exhibition and are provided here with a detailed description Moreover the reader is introduced to 41 representative items including visually captivating commercial and political posters related to Japan s modernity in the 1920s which represent mass culture progress and tensions and highlight both imperial ambitions and a willingness to contribute to international cooperation
